

Bulldogs Fall to Coyotes

The Golden Plains Bulldogs fell to the Weskan Coyotes in both A and B team games on the road February 5.

The A-team boys got off to a great start in the first quarter pulling ahead 11-4. They couldn't get anything to fall in the second quarter allowing the Coyotes to pull ahead 13-11 by the half.
