The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team scored well at the Logan Invitational Track Meet on May 7. The 7^{th} and 8^{th} grade boys combined for a total of 73 points for fourth place in their division, while the 6^{th} grade boys paced third with only three boys competing.

In the 7^{th} grade division, Austin Patmon placed in all four events including 6^{th} in 100m (13.75), second in 200m (27.45), second in the $4 \times 200m$ relay with teammates Dylan Spresser, Caleb Korte, and Jacob Ritter (1:57.45), and fourth as anchor on the medley relay with Jacob Ritter, Colby Lathrop, and Cameron Korte (2:11.21).

Dylan Spresser also placed in his events along with the relay. He finished second in 800m (2:32.06) and in long jump (14' 2.25"), and won the triple jump with a personal record of 35' 5". Caleb Korte finished third in 800m (2:38.72), fourth in 1600m (5:51.73), and just missed placing in shot with a throw of 28' 9.5".

Jacob Ritter added points by tying for second in high jump (4' 10") and fourth in triple jump (29' 10"). Final points were scored by Colby Lathrop for sixth place in 400m (1:16.67) and a fourth place finish in the 4 x 100m relay along with Miguel Monge, Joseph Yanez, and Cameron Korte (1:08.40).

The sixth grade team consisted of Wade Rush, Rolis Loya, and Toby Korte competing. Rush placed third in the 200m dash (31.11), second in 400m (1:13.06), and first in both shot put (30' 4") and discus (89' 8"). Loya placed third in 100m hurdles (24.65), sixth in triple jump (10' 8.75"), and fifth in high jump (3' 8"). He was 7^{th} in 100m (17.13). Korte finished in fifth place in 800m (3:22.73). He just missed points in 7^{th} place in discus (55' 5"). Results of additional events are listed below.
