

MS Girls Place at Logan Invitational

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs competed hard to earn top placings at the Logan Invitational Track Meet on May 7. The 7th and 8th grade girls combined for 3rd place with 76.4 points while the 6th grade girls earned 76 points for the meet championship.

In the 7th/8th division, KayCee Miller won top spot in the 100m (13.59) with Mabel Lugo coming in 3rd (14.40). Miller also took the top spot in the 200m (28.28) and placed 2nd in long jump (13' 4.25"). Lugo placed 2nd in 400m (1:08.73) and won the 800m run (2:55.49).

Additional points came from Candace Taylor in the 800m running 3:10.36 for 6th place. Malilah Green placed 5th in 1600m (7:07.33) with Marcela Monge placing 6th (7:17.80). The 4 x 100m relay team of Sable Finlay, Rileigh Korte, Candace Taylor, and Hayley Miller claimed 6th with a time of 1:07.11. The 4 x 200m relay team finished 3rd with a time of 2:06.97 run by Jaiden Koerperich, Mabel Lugo, Karri Schaben, and KayCee Miller. The medley relay team of Amanda Cheney, Taryn Fleckenstein, Marcela Monge, and Malilah Green came in 5th at 2:34.14.

In field events, Karri Schaben tied for 4th in high jump at 3' 10" and won triple jump with a personal best 27' 5" jump.

The sixth grade girls continue to turn in stellar performances on both the track and in the field. Brooke Stoll finished in second place in both the 100m (14.56) and the 200m (31.49) and won the 800m run with a personal best time of 2:56.20. She also placed 5th in long jump (11' 2.75"). Her sister, Ashley Stoll, won the 400m with a personal best 1:06.29, placed second in 100m hurdles (19.70) and won both high jump (4' 4") and long jump (12' 5").

Additional 6th grade points came from Hannah Bange who placed 6th in the 400m run (1:28.17) and in the 800m run (3:32.61). She placed 5th in the 100m hurdles and tied for 4th in high jump (3' 10"). Danica Ritter placed 5th in shot put with a personal record of 21' 6.5" and 6th in discus throwing 40' 2".
