MS Bulldogs Place Fourth at Husky Invitational By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team placed fourth at the Husky Invitational in Logan on April 21. The seventh and eighth graders competed as a middle school while the sixth graders competed in a separate division.

Dylan Spresser, 8th grade, and Austin Patmon, 7th grade, each placed in all four of their events. Spresser placed first in triple jump with a jump of 34'11.5", second in long jump at 14'6", third in the 800m at 2:45.36. He was also a member of the second place 4 x 200m relay team along with Caleb Korte, Jacob Ritter, and Austin Patmon. "Our season is going well," said Spresser. "We've been working hard and are starting to see results."

Along with the 4 x 200m relay, Patmon placed third in the 100m (13.69) and 200m (28.48) and fourth in the 400m (1:03). Jacob Ritter also placed fourth in the 100m hurdles (19.99) and fifth in the 200m hurdles (35.44), and long jumped 12' 6". Caleb Korte placed fourth in the 1600m run in addition to the second place finish in the 4 x 200m and threw the shot put 29' 4" and high jumped 4'4".
