

MS Boys Compete in Quinter

The GPMS Bulldogs competed at the Quinter Invitational on May 1. All grades competed together as one team. Austin Patmon, 7th grade, placed fourth in the 200m dash with a time of 27.98. He was a member of the fifth place 4 x 200m relay team (1:59.13) and the sixth place 4 x 400m relay team (4:43.85) with Jacob Ritter, Dylan Spresser, and Caleb Korte running on both relays.

Dylan Spresser also scored for Golden Plains with a long jump of 15' 3.5" for sixth place and placed second in triple jump at 34' 10". Wade Rush just missed scoring with a seventh place finish in Shot Put (30' 3.75") and Discus (95' 9") with over thirty competitors in each event. Caleb Korte finished eighth in Shot Put (30' 1") and the 3200m run (13:19.47) as did Jacob Ritter in the 100m hurdles (20.42).
