

Student Spotlight Selection Criteria

Golden Plains High School teachers and staff will select one student each month (September-April) to spotlight. Selection for this recognition will be based on the following criteria. Students may receive this recognition no more than one time during their high school career.

Academic Performance

- Does the student prepare for classroom activities?
- Does the student go above and beyond his/her role as a student?
- Has the student made significant progress in your classroom?
- Has the student been working to their potential?
- Does the student have all work turned in?
- Does the student have a good work ethic and is diligent?
- Is the student currently/consistently eligible?

Character

- Is the student a positive role model?
- Does the student demonstrate school spirit?
- Does the student actively participate and put forth full effort?
- Does the student demonstrate respect to the student body, staff, and faculty?
- Does the student exhibit good character?
- Does the student follow school rules?
- Does the student have regular attendance?
- Does the student arrive to school and to class on time?
- Does the student show acts of kindness?

Personal Development

- Does the student participate in extra-curricular activities?
- Does the student volunteer at school or in the community?
- Is the student a member of a club or organization outside of school?
- Does the student maintain an appropriate appearance/hygiene?
