## **Golden Plains Middle / High School**

### **Game Day Operations Fall 2020**

#### **Football**

##### **General:**

1. All KSHSAA Sports Specific Recommendations will be followed.
2. This policy was written with the safety of all participants in mind.
3. Hand sanitizer will be available in several locations throughout the facility.

##### **Fans:**

1. Fans will be allowed at all Golden Plains Middle / High School Football games.
2. USD 316 asks that all those paying at the gate wear a mask while doing so. This is for your safety and for the safety of those taking tickets.
3. Programs will be left on a table near each sides' bleachers.
4. Home and Away bleachers will be closed to the public. The Golden Plains Pep Band will use the home set of bleachers so that they may social distance during their performance.
5. Fans are asked to stay at their vehicles and behind the wire fence that separates the field from the parking area.
6. All fans are asked to social distance by staying at least 6 feet away from one another. If this can not occur, Golden Plains USD 316 highly recommends that masks be worn in those instances.
7. Fans are asked to follow the protocol for the concession stands area. This includes wearing a mask while in line and ordering food.
8. Fans are asked to stay off the field after games and to not socialize in large groups after the game has been completed.

### **Ticket takers:**

1. Money can be picked up in the office after 1:00 p.m.
2. Ticket takers are asked to wear masks and gloves while approaching cars. Masks may be taken off if not actively taking tickets and you can social distance. Masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer will be provided.
3. When finished, money is to be taken to the concession stand so that it can be picked up by administration after the game.
4. The gate money will not be counted by the office until Monday morning.

### **Concessions:**

1. All student and adult workers must wear masks at all times.
2. Those that buy food from the concession stand are asked to form a single file line
3. Those in line are asked to social distance if not with immediate family.
4. Anyone preparing food must also wear gloves.
5. All condiments must be of the prepackaged variety. ( Ketchup and Mustard.)
6. All sides (such as pickles, onions, etc) must be placed on the food by those preparing the food; a condiment tray can not be used.
7. The taking of money must be handled by 2 people set up at a table outside of the concession stand.

### **Referees:**

1. Referees will follow all guidelines set forth by the KSHSAA.
2. A locker room will be provided so that they can social distance.
3. Referees are asked to bring their own towels and soap for showering after the game.
4. Food and concessions will still be provided at halftime and then again after the game.

### **Participants:**

1. Players, coaches, and managers will practice social distancing.
2. Teams traveling to our facility will be asked to take their players' temperatures before leaving their campus.
3. Masks must be worn by all of the above while in the building and locker rooms.
4. If needed, the athletic director will provide two locker rooms for those teams with a large number of team members.
5. Towels and soap will not be provided to home or away teams. Each player is asked to bring their own.
6. After the game, a sign of sportsmanship will be given by each team. How that will be displayed will be determined by each school's administration prior to the game.
7. Water bottles and jugs will need to be filled at the field. Ice will not be provided for the away team by USD 316.

### **Volleyball**

#### **General:**

1. All KSHSAA Sports Specific Recommendations will be followed.
2. This policy was written with the safety of all participants in mind.
3. Hand sanitizer will be available in several locations throughout the facility.
4. All matches will be played in one gym. If an earlier start time is needed, the administration of both schools will need to approve of the new start time.
5. Fans will be allowed at all Golden Plains Middle/High School Volleyball matches.
6. **Fans are asked to wear masks while in the gym, commons, and restroom facilities.**

#### **Ticket takers:**

1. Money can be picked up in the office after 1:00 p.m.
2. Ticket takers are asked to wear masks and gloves while in the ticket booth. Masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer will be provided.
3. When finished, money is to be taken to the concession stand so that it can be picked up by administration after the game.

4. The gate money will not be counted by the office until the next morning.

### **Concessions:**

1. All student and adult workers must wear masks at all times.
2. Those that buy food from the concession stand are asked to form a single file line
3. Those in line are asked to social distance if not with immediate family.
4. Anyone preparing food must also wear gloves.
5. All condiments must be of the prepackaged variety. ( Ketchup and Mustard.)
6. All sides (such as pickles, onions, etc) must be placed on the food by those preparing the food; a condiment tray can not be used.
7. The taking of money must be handled by 2 people set up at a table outside of the concession stand.

### **Referees:**

1. All referees will follow the recommendations of the KSHSAA.

### **Participants:**

1. Coaches and those players on the bench, not actively participating, are asked to wear masks.
2. Bench players must stay within the 20-foot box as recommended by KSHSAA.
3. Teams traveling to our facility will be asked to take their player's temperatures before leaving their campus.
4. Players on the bench will be asked to social distance.
5. Both teams will be asked to provide their own volleyballs for warm-up. They must be collected by their own team members once their warm-up period has concluded.
6. Players will be asked to sanitize hands when leaving the floor after participating.
7. Teams will not switch benches between games.
8. If game officials feel one side of the court has an advantage over the other, teams will switch sides. If so, team benches will be sanitized before the other teams use the bench.
9. The game volleyball will be switched out between games to be sanitized. A new ball will be provided between each game and match.

### **Scholar's Bowl**

1. All participants, coaches, workers, and fans must wear masks while in the building.
2. Schools traveling to Golden Plains to compete must take the temperatures of those who plan to enter the building before they leave their home campus.
3. The moderator in each room may remove their masks to read questions during each round, They must wear their masks between rounds, and before the start of the following round.
4. Participants will be asked to bring their own pencil and paper to use during the competition.
5. Each participant will be asked to sanitize their hands before they enter the next room for competition.
6. Each classroom used for competition will be sanitized before the teams competing in the next round can enter the room.
