MS Boys Win Logan Meet By Anette Hernandez

The Golden Plains Middle School Boys won the Logan Invitational track meet on May 3 with 7th and 8th graders scoring 128 points.

Diego Perez won all four of his events including the 400m with a time of 1:02.78, the 1600m with a run of 5:37.28, and in Long Jump with a jump of 17' 01", and in Triple Jump at 32' 05". Perez has won the 1600m in all but one meet this season in which he set a PR and placed second. He has placed in the top 3 all season in triple jump and the top 4 in long jump and the 400m all season.

Dylan Wark placed first in the 800m running a time of 2:34.21 and placed first and broke the school record in the 200m hurdles for the second time this year with a time of 27.97. He had set a new record of 30.26 at Hill City the previous week. Dylan also placed third in high jump at 4' 10".

Placing second at the meet was Roberto Araux with a PR of 27.86 in the 200m and in the 400m with a 1:02.81 running it for the first time this season. Araux also placed third in the 100m hurdles at 35.46 and in the 100m hurdles at 18.53.

Zeke Weiner placed third in the 1600m (6:14.71) and in the 800m (2:52.74). Tanner Black placed third in Triple Jump (28' 2.25"), and finished fourth in both 400m (1:07.87) and in 100m (13.76), and Long Jumped 11' 7.5"

Javier Romero competed in 4 events including 100m 20.63, Shot Put 19' 9.5", Discus (53' 4" PR), Long Jump 7' 3.5"

The 6th grade division placed 5th overall with 10 points. Events included Tanner Todd-100m (6th place 18.11 PR), shot put (18' 5" PR), Discus (36' 5"), and Long Jump (6th place 9' 3.5" PR); Cristian Garcia-100m (7th place 18.12 PR), 200m (4th place 38.15), Shot Put (5th place 21' 1"), and Discus (7th place 46' 4"); Owen Amlong-200m (5th place 41.13), Shot Put (17' 7"), Discuss (41' 11"), and Long Jump (7th place 7' 8").

The MS boys competed again at the Colby Invitational on May 6.
