MS Girls Place Second at Colby Meet By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School seventh grade team placed second at the Colby Invitational Track Meet on May 6 with 6th and 7th grade girls combining for 101 total points. The eighth grade team also performed well with only two girls competing.

In the seventh grade division, sixth grader Mayte Hernandez won the 400m dash with a season record run of 1:12.82. Sixth grader Adilyn Meier set a season record run of 6:110.00 in the 1600m for first place with sixth grader Elizabeth Meier setting a PR of 6:18.95 for second. Meier and Weiner also claimed the top two spots in the 800m of 2:51.76 by Meier for first and 3:02.96 by Weiner for second.

Brenlynn Rath, also a sixth grader, set a PR of 18.73 for second place in the 100m hurdles and set a PR of 14' 0.25" for second in Long Jump. She tried Triple Jump for the first time and won first place with a 31' 6" jump.

The 4 x 400m relay team of Hernandez, Weiner, Meier, and Rath ran the best girls middle school time of the year of 4:55.24 to win first place. In the 4 x 200m relay, the girls placed third at 2:20.54 with Evelyn Ortiz, Addy Wessel, Marisol Perez, and Katie Carter running the laps. The 4 x 100m relay was run by Lakin Wark, Kailee Wessel, Estella Vargas, and Kadalen Unrein. These girls placed fourth with a 1:04.01 run.

Lakin Wark placed fourth in the 200m hurdles with a PR run of 37.61 and placed fifth in Triple Jump at 24' 5.5". Kailee Wessel also set PR of 40.14 in the 200m hurdles placing 7th. Unrein set a PR of 56' 4.5" in Discus for 5th place and just missed points in Shot Put in 7th place with a 23' 10.5" throw. Briella Knowles set a PR of 1:23.69 in the 400m event.

In other events, results were: 100m-Ortiz 16.04, Shayna Altman 17.83, Perez 18.14; 200m-Addy Wessel 36.79, Vargas 37.40, Perez 38.93; 400m-Altman 1:27.02; 200m hurdles-Unrein 40.76; High Jump-Carter 3' 8"; Long Jump-Vargas 7' 9.5"; Briella Knowles 7' 3.5"; Shot Put-A. Wessel 22' 4.75", Ortiz 20' 6.25"; Discus-K. Wessel 52' 4.25", Carter 50' 8.75".

In the eighth grade division, the Bulldogs only had two girls competing. They were able to score a total of 5 points and set a couple of PR's. Laura Moore placed fifth in 400m and set a PR of 33.42 in the 200m dash for 7th place. She also ran 15.85 in the 100m dash. Braylee Knowles placed fourth in Discus with a PR throw of 64' 7.5", set a PR of 17.42 in the 100m dash, and threw the Shot Put 24' 0.75". The girls finished their season on May 12 at the WKLL meet in Logan.
