The Golden Plains Middle School girls showed improvement in several events at the Quinter Track Meet on April 29. The girls posted 28 points as a team as they continue to decrease times and increase distances this season.

Sixth grader Adilyn Meier knocked 10 seconds off her time in the 1600m to place second at 6:07.12. Elizabeth Weiner placed in fourth place at 6:34.06. Meier also placed second in the 800m at 2:47.06 with Weiner coming in fifth at 3:01.58. Brenlynn Rath also posted a PR jump of 13' 8" in Long Jump for fourth place.

Two girls in the 200m posted PR times including Addy Wessel 36.02 and Estella Vargas 37.29. Vargas also ran a PR of 1:29.8 in the 400m. Anais Cepeda PR'd at 3:09.23 in the 800m run with Lakin Wark setting a PR of 20.87 in the 100m hurdles and Meier running a best time of 21.25 in this event. Kailee Wessel set a PR of 40.58 in the 200m hurdles.
