

Lady Bulldogs Set School Records By Judy Rogers

Three Lady Bulldogs have set new school records in their events during their track season so far.

Senior Emma Weiner set a new school record of 5:25.31 in the 1600m run at the Oakley Invitational on April 19. She broke her own record of 5:26.24 set in 2021. Emma also holds the school record in the 3200m run and as a member of the 4 x 800m relay team set in 2023. “It’s always exciting to set a new PR and a new record,” said Weiner. “Hopefully, I can continue to set new records in all of my events.”

In the middle school, eighth grader Elizabeth Weiner set a new school record of 13:07.49 in the 3200m run at the Rawlins County Invitational in Atwood on April 18. She broke her own record of 13:08.54 set in 2023. “It’s super exciting coming across the finish line knowing you’ve done your best,” said Weiner. “I want to keep improving and hopefully set a new 3200m record yet this year and set new records in high school.”

Eighth Grader Brenlynn Rath extended the school record in Triple Jump to 34’ 4.5” at the Northern Valley Invitational on April 11. She broke her own record set in 2023 of 33’ 5”. She extended that record to 34’ 5” at the Hill City meet on April 22.

Brenlynn also set a new school record in Long Jump at the Hill City Invitational on April 22 of 16’ 8.5”. The previous record was 16’ 3” set by Kristi Withers in 1989. “It’s really a cool experience and it’s exciting,” said Rath. “I’m really proud of myself because I wanted to set some record. I’ve wanted the long jump record since I started middle school and I was hoping to reset triple jump record. I really thought I could do it. I kept trying at Hill City and finally got it. It’s been a goal for a really long time. I’m kinda relieved to have gotten it as I’d be disappointed if I didn’t.”
