Registration deadline for December 9 ACT is November 3. Go to www.myact.org.

Kansas's first Apply Free Days will be held on November 7-9th, 2023, for Kansas residents! During these three days, any Kansas resident, regardless of age or income, can apply for free at any of our 7 public universities, 19 community colleges, 6 Technical colleges, and the 21 private member institutions of the Kansas Independent College Association. Eligible programs include general applications, certificate programs, associate degree programs, and bachelor degree programs.

All institutions will still have application fee waivers available during the entire year for students who qualify for financial hardship. Those forms will not be required during the Apply Free window. (Remember- Kansas Community Colleges, PSU, Washburn U, and many of our private institutions never have general application fees. They are free to apply to everyday!) Find out more at www.kansasregents.org/students/apply-free-days.

Are you interested in Emporia State? Now is the best time for them to apply! The application for undergraduate admission is FREE until November 10th. This saves you the \$30 application fee. Students cannot apply for scholarships or housing until they are admitted, so even if they aren't positive that they want to attend Emporia, one should still apply. Students who apply to Nebraska Wesleyan University (NWU) by November 1 will receive a \$500 renewable P-Wolf Priority Scholarship. Apply at https://slate.nebrwesleyan.edu/apply/. But there's more.

The Access NWU Scholarship Program funds 100% of tuition for all first-year or transfer students who qualify for the federal Pell Grant. The program serves most students whose family adjusted gross incomes are at or below \$65,000. At NWU, more than 40 percent of our incoming class of students are Pell Grant recipients. With a \$0 balance for tuition, students may use community scholarships, student loans and campus employment for other expenses.
