

GPHS Girls Win at Logan

The Golden Plains High School Lady Bulldogs claimed a win against the Lady Trojans in Logan on January 6.

The Bulldogs took the beginning tip-off and worked to stay ahead of the Trojans, claiming the first quarter 12-7. In the second quarter, the Lady Bulldogs struggled to get more than one basket to fall, but were able to play solid defense to hold Logan to only two points as well.

Returning back from halftime with a new mindset, the Lady Bulldogs were able to outscore the Trojans 15-13, making the score 29-22. In the final quarter of play, Golden Plains continued to work hard to keep the lead. At the ending buzzer, the Lady Bulldogs added the 41-32 win, moving their record to 4-2.

Schiltz and sophomore KayCee Miller led the Bulldogs with 11 points each. Senior Morgan Ritter and junior Kaylie Schaben added 8 points apiece, and freshman Mabel Lugo put in 3 points. Ritter led with 9 rebounds, Miller-8, Lugo-8, Schaben-6, and Schiltz-5. Miller had 4 steals, Schiltz-2, Lugo-2, and junior Maggi Nieman-1. Seniors Schiltz and Ritter each had 2 assists, and Schaben had 1.

The Bulldogs take on the St. Francis Indians on January 7 in Rexford and then will match-up against Western Plains/Healy on January 13 in Rexford.
