

Girls Place Third at Meet By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains 7th and 8th grade girls placed third at the Northern Valley Invitational in Logan on April 13 with 91 points. Logan placed first with 102 and Northern Valley was second at 93.

Three of the events won first place at the meet including Brooke Stoll in the 800m run with a personal record (PR) of 2:44.9, Kassie Miller in Discus with a 69'0" throw, and the 4 x 100m medley with a season best 2:12.0 ran by Kassie Miller, Hannah Bange, Ashley Stoll, and Brooke Stoll.

Several of the girls had second place finishes. This included Kassie Miller in Shot Put (32' 7.25"), Ashley Stoll with a PR in 100m hurdles (20.21), and the 800m relay with a season best time of 2:21.8 run by Amie Cheney, Berenice Villa, Rayna Taylor, and Morgan Wark.

The 400m relay also turned in an improved time of 59.73 seconds from Brooke Stoll, Kassie Miller, Carli Nieman, and Ashley Stoll for third place while Nieman set a third place PR of 7:07.0 the 1600m run.

Placing fourth were Morgan Wark-100m hurdles (20.58), Wark-200m hurdles (37.01), Wark-shot put (29'2"), and Hannah Bange-1600m (7:41.0). Fifth place points were awarded to Danica Ritter with a PR of 59'3" in discus, Nieman with a PR in high jump of 3' 10", Lauren Patmon-1600m (7:53.3), and Amie Cheney-200m hurdles (43.0). A final point was awarded to Bange for sixth place in triple jump (24' 3.5").

The sixth grade competed separately from the middle school girls scoring 64 points. Breanna Rath placed first in long jump (13' 3.5") and second in the 100m hurdles (19.23). Jazline Manriquez also placed first in the 400m run (1:15.5) and in the 800m run (2:57.3). These girls were also members of the second place season best (1:03.5) 400m relay team along with Sidney Taylor and McHaley Carter.

Carter placed third in long jump (11' 7.5") and sixth in the 200m dash (34.63) while Taylor placed third in the 800m run (3:04.0). The girls will compete again in Quinter on April 28.
