The Golden Plains High School boys track team showed improvement in several events at the Quinter Track Meet on April 29 despite some events not being completed due to lightening delays and stormy weather. "This would have been a good meet if not for the weather," said Landon Meier. "We've improved from last year and hope to continue improving for League and Regionals."

The Bulldogs placed in two events at this meet. Points came from the 4 x 800m relay team of Alex Gonzalez, Landon Meier, Ethan Shea, and Ethan Weiner finishing fourth with a time of 9:30.28. Weiner placed fourth in the 1600m running 5:18.57. Just missing out on points in 7<sup>th</sup> place were Ashton Schiltz-Shot Put 38' '8" and Landon Meier-1600m 5:34.97

Wyatt Amlong and Brandon Luna both improved their times in the 100m to 14.31 and 21.98 respectively. Dominic Stout decreased his time in the 110m hurdles to 23.13. Ethan Shea increased his distance in the Long Jump to 16'3" and Josh Rath improved in Triple Jump to 24' 1.5". In Shot Put, Garrett Carter improved to 36' 8" and Will Bruggeman threw a PR of 29' 9".
