Lady Bulldogs Place Third in Logan By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs Track Team placed third at the Logan Invitational on May 3 with a total of 79 points scored. Despite some tough competition, the girls' team has placed in the top six at every meet so far this season.

Breanna Rath placed first in the 300m hurdles at 51.91 and first in Triple Jump at 34' 5". She placed second in the 100m hurdles with a 17.76 run and ran the third leg of the second place 4 x 400m Relay team with Kassie Miller, Anette Hernandez, and Sidney Taylor running the other laps. They finished in 4:44.43.

Hernandez placed second in the 1600m run with a time of 6:08.22 and fourth in 800m at 2:54.21. She also ran the second leg of the second place 4 x 800m Relay team along with Ava Brantley, Rayna Taylor, and Sidney Taylor with an 11:23.08 run.

Sidney Taylor placed third in the 800m run (2:45.60) with Rayna Taylor placing fifth (3:05.00). Rayna also set a PR of 6:42.71 for sixth place in the 1600m. Kassie Miller set a PR of 34' 4" for third place in Shot Put and placed fourth in Discus with a 99' 9" throw. The 4 x 100m Relay team of Mariah Barnett, Kassie Miller, Sidney Taylor, and Ava Brantley ran the fastest relay time of the season of 58.07 for fourth place.

Hayden Wark set a PR of 32.90 in the 200m and jumped 12' 5.5" in Long Jump and 28' 6.25" in Triple Jump. Barnett Long Jumped 12' 11" and finished the 100m in 15.20 and the 200m in 32.82. Carli Nieman ran the 100m in 16.72 and threw the Discus 66' 9". Ava Brantley ran the 200m in 31.47, Emma Carter threw the Shot Put 24' 5.5" and the Javelin 45' 2", and Morgan Wark threw Shot Put 32' 2" and the Discus 84' 1". The girls competed again on May 6 in Colby.
