Sixth Grade Girls Win Logan Invite

The Golden Plains Middle School sixth grade girls won the Logan Invitational Track Meet in Logan on May 3. The ladies combined for a total of 141 points to win the meet ahead of runner up Brewster with 52 points. The $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade girls posted 64 points for fourth place. Every girl competing was able to contribute points to the overall totals for the team.

In the sixth grade division, Brenlynn Rath accounted for 40 points with a first place medal in all four of her events. She won the $100 \mathrm{~m}(14.71), 200 \mathrm{~m}(30.35), 100 \mathrm{~m}$ hurdles (18.92), and Long Jump with a PR of 13' 10". Also awarded first place medals were Mayte Hernandez with a PR of 1:13.02 in 400m and Adilyn Meier in 800m at 2:50.05.

Second place points were awarded to Hernandez-200m 31.96, Meier-400m 1:14.54, Elizabeth Weiner-800m 2:58.45, and $4 \times 100 \mathrm{~m}$ Relay-Weiner, Lakin Wark, Briella Knowles, Meier 1:04.19.

Placing third were Hernandez-100m 15.71, Weiner-400m 1:18.63, Wark-100m Hurdles 20.60 (PR) Long Jump 11' 4.5", and Evelyn Ortiz-Shot Put 21' 7.5" (PR). Fourth place went to Ortiz-100m 16.08 800m 3:20.61, Wark-200m 33.35, Meier-100m hurdles 21.43.

Fifth place points were earned by Hernandez-High Jump 3' 6" with Briella Knowles placing sixth in Shot Put at $18^{\prime} 3.5$ " and jumping $8^{\prime} 2.25$ in Long Jump.

In the $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade division, Anais Cepeda placed second in both 800 m with a PR of $3: 07.10$ and in 1600 m with a PR of $6: 53.51$. The $4 \times 200 \mathrm{~m}$ relay team of Katie Carter, Marisol Perez, Estella Vargas, and Kailee Wessel placed second with a time of 2:23.70 and the Medley Relay team of Addy Wessel, Kadalen Unrein, Braylee Knowles, and Cepeda placed second at 2:26.24.

The $4 \times 100 \mathrm{~m}$ relay team of K. Wessel, Vargas, Katie Carter, and Braylee
Knowles finished in third place with a 1:06.43 run. Fourth place was awarded to Laura Moore-100m 16.02, A. Wessel-200m 37.36 1600m 7:44.0, Unrein-200m Hurdles 39.73, and Cepeda-Triple Jump 24' 6".

Vargas placed fifth in 200 m (38.41) and K. Wessel was fifth in 100m Hurdles (21.83). Perez finished sixth in the 200 m dash at 39.24 . Additional results include: 100m-Vargas 17.45 (PR), Perez 17.98, Shot Put-Braylee Knowles 25' 11 ", Unrein 25' 6" (PR), Discus-K. Wessel 56' 5", Unrein 55’ 6" (PR), Braylee Knowles 54’ 2".

The girls competed again at the Colby Invitational on May 6.
