The Golden Plains High School boys placed third in their first track meet of the season in Hoxie on April 6.

Freshman Dylan Wark placed first in the 110m Hurdles with a time of 18.96. He placed second in the 300m hurdles at 46.66 and was a member of the third place 4 x 400m relay along with Iu Ribera, Landon Meier, and Josh Rath with a 4:03.73 run. "Placing first in the hurdles was a nice way to start the season and my high school career," said Wark. "I hope to continue to improve and qualify for state."

Junior Iu Ribera placed third in triple jump with a 34' 8.75" jump as Sophomore Josh Rath placing fourth at 34' 7.75". Junior Landon Meier placed fourth in the 800m run at 2:30.76 and fifth in the 1600m run with a time of 5:38.60. Ezekiel Weiner followed him in sixth place in the 1600m with a 5:36.99 run. A final team point was scored by Junior Will Bruggeman in discus with a sixth place throw of 98' 0".

Dylan Wark just missed out on points in the 800m run with a seventh place time of 2:42.84. Ezekiel Weiner placed 7th in the 3200m run at 12:05.96, Dominic Stout finished in 7th place in the 300m hurdles with a 57.56 run, and Tanner Black placed 7th in Triple Jump at 30' 4.25".'
