

## GP Girls Set Records at Login Invite By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldog Track team set multiple Personal Records (PR) for the season at the Logan Invitational Track Meet in Phillipsburg on May 2. Together the girls scored 69 points for third place and set a PR in 8 events.

Senior Breanna Rath continues to place first in both Long Jump and Triple Jump. She jumped 15' 9.5" in long jump and 35' 8" in triple jump for the title. Junior Emma Weiner also placed first in the 1600m run with a time of 5:36.77 and second in the 800m running in 2:35.67. This was her first time running the 800m in high school.

The relay teams also claimed second with the 4 x 400m team of Anette Hernandez, Rath, Sidney Taylor, and Weiner running a PR time of 4:35.63. The same girls ran the 4 x 800m in 10:53.08 for runner up.

Taylor set a PR in the 800m of 2:41.52 for third while Jordyn Fleckenstein set a PR of 2:47.87 for fifth. Hernandez set a PR of 6:06.49 in the 1600m run placing third. The final team point was set by Siena Vargas with a 24' 5.75" Triple Jump for sixth.

Additional PR's were set by Siena Vargas in 100m (15.68), 200m (32.62), and Long Jump (11' 5.75") and by Ava Brantley in the 200m (32.48). "I think we all did very good at this meet, both boys and girls," said Vargas. "We hope to continue to improve and have a large number of athletes qualify for state."

Results from additional events include: 100-Brantley 15.62, Discus-Fleckenstein 73' 11", Valentina Bermudez 62' 3", Javelin-Fleckenstein 72' 7", and Shot Put-Bermudez 27' 4".

The girls look to continue to improve as they compete at the Colby Invitational on May 5 at Dennen Field in Colby.
