

GP Gets Back on Winning Streak

The Golden Plains volleyball team traveled to Wallace Co. on Saturday, September 24 to play two matches against the Wallace Co. Lady Wildcats and the Weskan Lady Coyotes. The Bulldogs went undefeated on the day to advance their record 14-7. Golden Plains is currently ranked 7th in the KVA rankings for Division II 1A.

To start the day, the Lady Bulldogs took on the Lady Wildcats. GP worked well on the floor and stayed right with the Wildcats, never falling behind. The Wildcats stayed within one to two points of the Bulldogs until the very end, when an ACE serve from Breanna Rath finished the set 28-26. The Lady Bulldogs started the second set with a nice run and took off from there. Jordyn Fleckenstein played the net really well, stopping the Wildcats from attacking the ball. GP claimed the second set 25-20.

The second and final match for GP was against the Weskan Lady Coyotes. Rath went on an eight point serving run before the Coyotes were able to send the ball back over the net. The first set ended in favor of the Bulldogs 25-6. The Coyotes came alive for the second set, but not enough to keep the Bulldogs from claiming the 25-20 victory. "We played really well against both teams," claimed Hayden Wark. "These two wins were exactly what we needed to get back into the groove of things."

The Lady Bulldogs will have an off-week and resume their season on October 4 in Almena to compete against Northern Valley and Triplains/Brewster.
