Records Set at Hill City By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team set new records at the Hill City meet on April 24. The sixth and seventh grade girls combined for 105 point to place first at the meet.

In the seventh grade division, Brenlynn Rath set another new school record in Triple Jump of 33' 2.5". She had set a new school record of 32' 7.5" at the first meet of the season, then extended it to 33' 1" at the second. This is her third school record in three meets. Rath also placed first in Long Jump with a 14' 0.5" jump and first in the 200m Hurdles with a PR run of 33.09.

This is the first year that WKLL Middle School students could compete in Javelin. This was the first meet that any GP students competed. Seventh grader Mayte Hernandez did not place but established the school record with a 58' 10" throw. Hernandez also placed first in the 400m dash with a 1:09.33 run, third in the 200m dash at 31.13, and ran on the second place 4 x 400m Relay team along with Rath, Elizabeth Weiner, and Adilyn Meier finishing in 5:00.71.

"I enjoyed throwing javelin for the first time for our school," said Hernandez. "I hope to continue to throw and improve my distance." "I was really impressed and excited that we placed first at this meet," added Herandez. "There were a lot of schools and many were bigger school. We hope to improve on every event and earn more plaques and medals."

Meier also placed first in the 1600m run with a PR of 6:11.94, and second in the 800m run with a 2:49.61 PR. She just missed out on points in the 400m finishing seveth with a 1:13.58 run. Weiner placed first in the 3200m run with a 13:40.0 finish and third in the 1600m with a PR of 6:25.05. The Bulldogs had four of the top six spots in the 1600m with Briella Knowles placing fourth with a PR of 7:25.80 and Alicia Vargas running 7:34.23 for fifth.

The girls' 4 x 200m relay was run by Kaydence Cregger, Estrella Aguilar, Alicia Vargas, and Evelyn Ortiz. They placed third with a 2:21.36 run. Lakin Wark placed fourth in high jump at 4' 0" and sixth in the 100m hurdles running in 20.71 seconds.
