

Sixth Graders Place at Logan

The Golden Plains sixth grade track team placed at the Logan Invitational in Stockton on May 2. The girls placed third and the boys placed fifth at this meet.

For the girls, who placed third with 61 points, Alicia Vargas set a PR of 3:01.38 to claim first place in the 800m. She also set a PR of 1:17.60 for second in the 400m. As a member of the 4 x 100m Relay team along with Elizabeth Romero, Kaydence Cregger, and Estrella Aguilar, they placed second with a 1:07.38 run.

Jade Dible placed first in High Jump with a 3' 8" jump while Cregger placed 4th at 3' 2" and Aguilar was 5th at 3' 0". In the 200m, Romero was 4th at 36.92, Aguilar 5th at 37.57, and Dible 6th at 39.01. Romero also placed 5th in the 400m dash at 1:38.28 and Aguilar placed 4th in the 800m with a PR at 3:13.60.

In the Discus, Cregger finished 4th with a 40' 8" throw while Dible set a PR of 39' 8" for 5th and ran the 100m in 22.16. Yarely Romo threw the Shot a PR of 27' 11" placing 7th, placed 7th in Shot Put with a 15' 2" throw, and ran the 100m in 17.77. Cregger also set a PR in the 100m dash of 16.88 while Romero placed 7th in Long Jump at 9' 11".

The sixth grade boys placed fifth with 19 points. The 4 x 100m Relay team of Koen Schaben, Brandon Karnes, Nash Ziegelmeier, and Parker Vahling placed first with a time of 1:09.71. Vahling placed 2nd in the 400m dash with a 1:16.79 run, and Schaben placed sixth in Long Jump at 9' 1".

Vahling set a PR of 32.41 in the 200m while Schaben set a PR of 36.08. Karnes set a PR of 7' 8.5" in Long Jump and Ziegelmeier set a PR of 43' 5" in the Discus.
