

Lady Bulldog Perform at Oakley

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldog track team delivered many improved performances at the Oakley Invitational Track meet on April 19.

Senior Emma Weiner scored all the Bulldog points with first place in the 800m (2:31.71), 1600m (5:25.31), and the 3200m (11:59.03). The 800m and 1600m were season best runs with the 1600m setting a new school record.

All three girls in the 100m dash set new personal best times including Kailee Wessel (15.14), Ava Brantley (15.61), and Wendy Garcia (16.31). All three girls in Discus also set personal best distances for the season including Jordyn Fleckenstein (80' 1"0), Valentina Bermudez (73' 0"), and Katie Carter (61' 0").

Garcia also set a PR in the 200m dash of 33.48 and in the 400m run at 1:21.27. Kailee Wessel set another PR in the 400m of 1:16.87, and Katie Carter set a PR in the 200m of 34.56. Ava Brantley ran a 34.51 in the 200m just 0.01 seconds away from her PR. Additional PR's were set by Estella Vargas in Long Jump (11' 9") and Hayden Wark in Triple Jump (28' 7").

Results of other events include: 400m-Vargas 1:27.76, 300m Hurdles-Wark 1:05.30, Long Jump-Wark 13' 6", Triple Jump-Vargas 24' 9", Javelin-Fleckenstein 75' 1.5", Bermudez 57' 4", Carter 53' 3". The 4 x 100m relay team of Fleckenstein, Carter, Brantley and Wark finished in 1:01.42. The team will compete again at the Quinter Invitational on April 26.
