MS Girls Win Northern Valley Invite By Jaqueline Manriquez

The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team traveled to Northern Valley on April 11 for their first track meet of the season. The 7th and 8th grade combined points to win the meet with 136 points.

Brenlynn Rath placed 1st and got a new school record for triple jump with a jump of 34' 4 1/2''. She also placed first in the long jump with a jump of 14' 4'' and second in the 200m hurdles with a time of 35.78.

The 800m relay team with Evelyn Ortiz, Elizabeth Weiner, Adilyn Meier, and Kaylee Kier placed second with a time of 2:11.2. The same four girls placed first in the 800m medley relay with a 2:15.1 run.

Lakin Wark won high jump with a jump of 4'6". Weiner won the 1600m with a time of 6:07.8. She also won the 800m with a time of 2:52.5. Meier followed her in second place in the 1600m with a time of 6:09.6 and finished second in the 800m at 2:52.9.

Briella Knowles finished the 1600m with a time of 7:21.3 in 6th place. She also placed 6th in triple jump with a jump of 26'4", and placed fifth in the 800m at 3:30.8. Evelyn Ortiz threw the shot put 24'11 1/2" for sixth place.

Jade Dible long jumped 12' 9.5" for fifth place and placed third in the relay along with Elizabeth Romero, Kaylee Kier, and Grecia M-Gonzalez with a time of 1:03.3.

Molly Ritter placed first in the 100m hurdles with a 20.26 run, 3rd in high jump with 4'4" jump, fourth in the 200m hurdles (27.91), and fifth in the 400m run (1:17.2). Gonzalez also ran the 100m hurdles placing second with a time of 21.31 and Makynslee Vargas ran the 800m in 3:36.3 for sixth place.

Their next track meet was at Rawlins County in Atwood on April 18.
