What is a School Liaison?

The role of a school liaison is to connect guardians, school, and High Plains Mental Health providers to students with behavioral issues, poor attendance, and academics.



Ask for help if:

- You struggle to appropriately control behaviors in school
- You are anxious, sad, or overwhelmed
- You struggle with class work
- You have difficulty with coming to school

MENTAL HEALTH MATTERS

This program is designed to access mental health services while getting rid of barriers for students and families in need of services.

The program allows for convenient times and locations (often in school) to best serve families. All services are provided by a licensed therapist.
